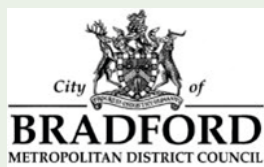

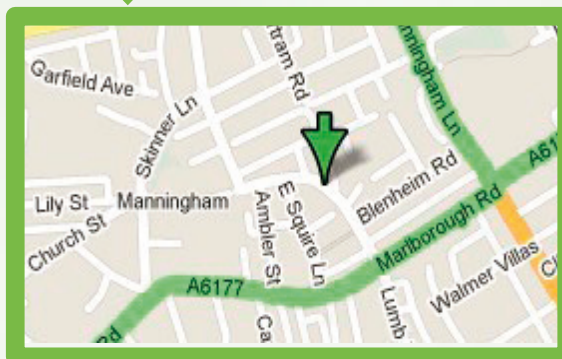

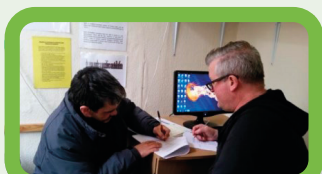

Aims and Objectives

The aim of our RSP service is to provide supported housing to extremely vulnerable single men and women, who have had experiences of rough sleeping. Service users will benefit from an intensive package of support. As well as develop their life skills we focus on issues such as substance misuse, mental health and other health related matters in order to promote the individual's emotional and physical needs.

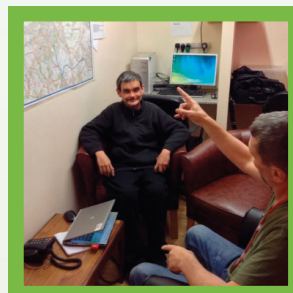


Support

Using a support planning approach Bradford Cyrenians will deliver a housing related and housing management service providing support and assistance in a number of key areas Including:

- ◆ Sorting out welfare benefits
- ◆ Providing budgeting and debt management support
- ◆ Develop and enhance life skills
- ◆ Increase the clients confidence and self esteem.
- ◆ Accommodation is available for up to 12 months.

We have 10 units of fully furnished accommodation, of which 2 units are allocated for women.



Eligibility Criteria

Each service user must be:

- ◆ Have an active benefit claim
- ◆ Homeless or about to become homeless
- ◆ Have had experiences of rough sleeping
- ◆ Must have a vulnerability which renders them in need of a support service
- ◆ Must be capable of living in the community, providing that support is made available
- ◆ Must have support needs rather than care needs
- ◆ Must be willing to engage with the service and the support offered

Referral Process

We accept self referrals and accept referrals from other agencies who work with vulnerable men and women. Please contact us to make a referral
